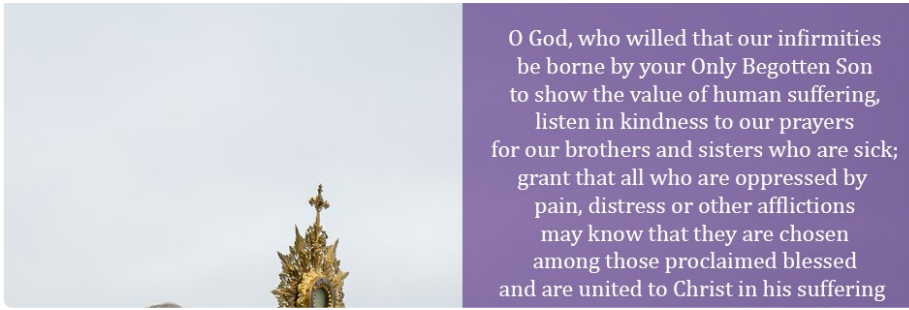
O God, who willed that our infirmities
